

A Woman Healed
Mark 5:21-34
Study Questions

Read Mark 5:21-34. What does Mark 5:21-24 indicate about the people around Jesus?

Read Leviticus 15:19-30 to help you understand the woman's position.

Questions for the text:

1. What does Mark 5:25-26 tell us about the woman's situation?
2. Why does she approach Jesus? What does Mark tell us about her approach in verse 27?
3. What happens to her (v. 29)? What did Jesus do (v. 30-32)? What is her response (v. 33)?
4. What does Jesus call her in verse 34? How does what he tells her differ from what already happened to her in verse 29? What has changed for this woman?

Questions for you:

1. Have you ever felt isolated? What keeps you out of relationships with other people? In what ways have you suffered? What have you done to try to alleviate or manage your suffering?
2. How do you think this woman feels as she approached Jesus? How do you approach him? Do you feel unworthy of his attention?
3. What kind of healing would you like to ask of Jesus? How have you been changed by approaching Jesus?
4. What is your relationship with Jesus? How has that changed your relationship with other people?
